Mr. Chordia shared his contribution towards sustainable agrotourism. He has played a pivotal role in shaping the legacy of this renowned brand.

According To Mr. Chordia Agro-tourism is a fascinating blend of agriculture and tourism, presenting both opportunities and challenges for farmers and businessmen. He also explained the opportunities in the field of agro tourism like Agrotourism provides farmers with an additional source of income, reducing dependency on traditional agriculture. It creates

employment opportunities in various sectors such as hospitality, transportation, and handicrafts. The resource person also added that Sustainable agrotourism practices prioritize environmental conservation by promoting organic farming, biodiversity preservation, and responsible land management.

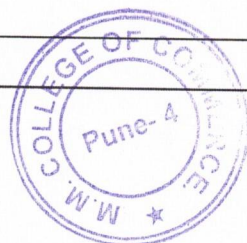

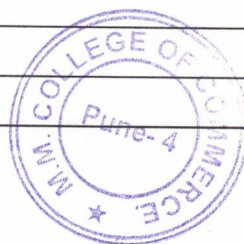

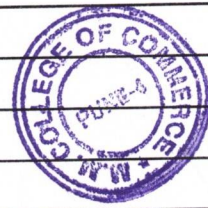

### Conclusion:


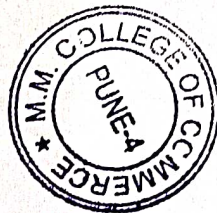
