NSS Day Celebration with Blood Donation and Health Awareness Camp at MM's Deccan Campus

On September 24, 2019, to mark **NSS Day**, the NSS Unit of Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Commerce, in collaboration with **Gholap Blood Bank**, **Pune**, organized a **Blood Donation Camp** along with multiple health awareness activities. The event took place at **MM's Deccan Campus**, **Pune**, benefiting both students and faculty through various health initiatives.

On June 23, 2019, Savitribai Phule Pune University organized a Guinness World Record attempt for a large-scale tree plantation activity along *Palkhi Marg*, (**Dehu Alandi to Pandharpur route aound 223 km**) a historically significant route associated with the annual Wari pilgrimage.
