



The NSS Team got second prize in this competition. A total of 12 NSS volunteers had participated in this street play competition.








Event Highlights:

Report on the Red Dot Awareness Campaign

Location: Sadashiv Peth, Pune Date: Friday, January 28, 2022

As part of extension activities focusing on cleanliness and health issues related to women's hygiene, the girl students of SYBBA(CA) from Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Commerce College took a proactive initiative to generate awareness on appropriate sanitary waste management.

Objective: The campaign aimed to educate young girls and the community about the importance of proper disposal of sanitary waste and the significance of the 'Red Dot' — a simple yet effective method to inform waste collectors about sanitary waste, ensuring both safety and dignity in waste management practices.

Activities Conducted:

- The students visited multiple schools in the vicinity and conducted interactive sessions with schoolgirls and teachers.
- Using charts, posters, and live demonstrations, they explained how to mark sanitary waste with a red dot before disposal.



Report on NSS Special Residential Camp 2021-2022

Location: Mouje Chinchwad, Post: Belawade, Taluka: Mulshi, District: Pune

The seven-day residential NSS Special Residential Camp of Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Commerce was successfully conducted at Mouje Chinchwad, Post: Belawade, Taluka: Mulshi, District: Pune from January 30, 2022, to February 5, 2022.

A total of 55 volunteers participated in the camp, including 22 girl students and 33 boy students. The camp's inauguration took place on January 31, 2022, at 11:00 AM in Chinchwad by the hands of the founder of Lokseva Parivar, Hon. Mr. Manikkaka Shedge and Mrs. Shubhangitai Shedge, with great enthusiasm. The event was presided over by the college principal, Dr. Devidas Golhar. The Sarpanch of Chinchwad village, Mrs. Shobha Dnyaneshwar Khandare, along with members of the Chinchwad Gram Panchayat, esteemed dignitaries, and citizens were present. Faculty members from the college, including Prof. Sarang Edke, Dr. Nasir Shaikh, Dr. Muralidhar Gaikwad, and Dr. Sandeep Anpat, also graced the occasion. The inauguration ceremony was compered by NSS Programme Officer Prof. Pravin Kad, with the welcome address by Prof. Sushil Gangane and the vote of thanks by Prof. Amol Chaudhary.

During the camp, various rural development activities were undertaken in Chinchwad village. These included Shramdaan (voluntary labor), village surveys, the "My Village - Corona-Free Village" campaign, water conservation, environmental awareness, superstition eradication and de-addiction, gender sensitivity awareness, social enlightenment, street plays, intellectual discussions, group discussions, and cultural programs.
