Overview:

III. DISCLAIMER

Nothing in this MOU constitutes a grant, express or implied, by either party to the other of any license or rights whatsoever to the intellectual property of a party that may exist at the time this MOU is entered. No party makes any representations or warranties, expressed or implied, regarding any information shared, or its performance, under this MOU, including but not limited to any warranty of the merchantability, use or fitness for any particular purpose of any research results and any warranty against infringement of any intellectual property rights.

Each party will be responsible for its own actions and those of its employees under this MOU.

IV. TERM AND CONDITIONS

This MOU is non-exclusive and shall be effective on the date first set forth above ("Date: 13 · 1 · 2022"), and shall survive for **One year** from the Effective Date. The parties may modify or extend this Agreement at any time by mutual written consent. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by giving the other party not less than thirty (30) days prior written notice. The terms of Section IV above shall survive termination of this MOU. Upon termination of this MOU and by request of a party, each party shall promptly return (or destroy at the request of each party) any and all proprietary information provided by the other party.

V. BREACH OF CONTRACT

Under no circumstances any of the parties can directly or indirectly contact either of the respective employees of the organization for commercial interest.

It will be subject to legal consequence in view of any such occurrence.

VI. Clause of Mediation

Mediation as a step prior to litigation.

The parties mutually agree that incase of any dispute or claim (hereinafter referred to as dispute) arising out of or relating to this MOU contract, the parties shall first engage in good faith negotiation to resolve the dispute. In case the dispute is not settled within <u>7 days</u> it shall be referred to mediation, city Pune and language of mediation, English / Marathi.

Exclusive Clause: Non-compete provisions, limiting third - party relationship for business partners.

Governing Clause: This MOU shall be Governed by and construed in accordance with the law of the state.

VII. GENERAL

Each party is an independent contractor and is independent of the other party. This MOU does not create a partnership, joint venture or agency relationship of any kind between the parties. This MOU does not create any fiduciary or other obligation between the parties. Neither party shall have any right, power or authority under this MOU to act as a legal representative of the other party, and neither party shall have any right or authority to bind or obligate the other or make any representation or warranty on behalf of the other. Under no circumstances shall any employees of one party be deemed the employees of the other party for any purpose. Each party is responsible for the direction and compensation of its employees. Each party acknowledges that the relationship of the parties hereunder is non-exclusive.

Neither party shall imply the endorsement of the other or use publicly for publicity, promotion or otherwise, any logo, name, trade name, service mark or trademark (including music and colors) of the other party, or any simulation, abbreviation, or adaptation of the same, or the name of any employee or agent of the other party, without the other party's prior written, express consent.


Workshop Details:
