Extension of the centre was obtained.2. To increase the student strength number efforts were taken to increase the number of Research Guides.3. Dr. Nasir Shaikh is approved as a Research Guide for the subject Economics and Dr. Sheetal Lakde is approved as a Research Guide for the subject Cost & Accounts.• Progress of Nodal center of IIRS-ISRO at college: As part of IQAC initiative, the linkages/tie-up/collaboration with various State/National/International bodies the IIRS-ISRO Nodal Center was established under this a certificate course, “Fundamentals of Remote Sensing course” was conducted at college; 52 students of TY B.Sc (CS) and a few faculty members have successfully completed the course.



- **Review of Competitive Examination Center (CEC):**

The College established Competitive Exam Guidance Center as suggested by the peer team recommendations of previous NAAC visit with the prime objective of imparting quality education to the students and nurturing them for various competitive examinations. - g. Foreign language courses**

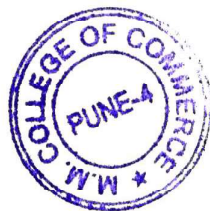
- h.** In order to institutionalize the foreign language, the college has taken initiative to start a certificate course in German language. Due to the time constraints the college could start the batch of 10 students with immediate effect in AY 2022-23 out of which 8 students have attempted the exam, the results of the exam are yet to be declared. Prof. Tukaram Patil and Prof. Sushil Gangane were appointed as Co-ordinators of the certificate course. In the academic year 2023-24 the college will be initiating the batch of four languages i.e. German, French, Spanish and Japanese languages, the batch will be of 44 students each for all four languages; however the minimum intake prescribed by the university is of 20 students.



a. PGRC progression and future plans

The discussion took place in the meeting regarding the current status of the PostGraduate Research Centre. The college has received the affiliation letter from 2020-2021 up to 31/01/2023 by SPPU. Even Considering this the following points were discussed and require action to be taken in due course of time.

- 2) After the rigorous follow up with BMCC College and SPPU, we have successfully received the change of centre letter issued by SPPU for Ms. Prajakta Chipulnkar and Mrs. Bhavana Shah under the guideship of Dr. N. B. Shaikh. Also the centre has informed both of them were guided by PGRC centre to complete the admission and other formalities towards the accomplishment of their Ph.D.
- 3) Ph. D fee structure was decided if approval was sought in the CDC Committee meeting held on 02.07.2022.
- 4) To seek the permission from Management to process the permanent approval process for currently working faculties, those are eligible to get the Ph.D recognition approval from SPPU.
- 5) Dr. Sheetal Lakde of Sarhad College of Arts , Commerce and Science who is a recognised Ph. D guide of SPPU has been appointed as Associate Guide at our PGRC Centre and the vacancy was communicated to SPPU for Ph.D admission. Consequently, the Ph.D. candidate list with guide as Dr. Sheetal Lakde was received from SPPU and accordingly the interviews were conducted on 08th June, 2022. Finally, on 7th July, 2022 the 3 candidates were approved from SPPU to our centre.

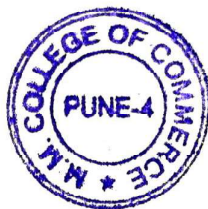
The fee collection status was as per the admissions for the academic year. In addition, the institute also considers economically weaker students and provides them with financial assistance/concession as part of the welfare of masses.

- b. **Website Development:**

The Website Development Committee is keen towards updating the college website. A new vendor Mr. Shivam Maheja of Tinfosystem was finalized for the website development recently. Meetings are conducted from time to time by the committee. The updated website will be live for the admissions of academic year 2023-24.

- c. **Budget sanctioned and expenditure incurred**

The budget of all departments is prepared and submitted for the academic year 2023-24.



d. Scholarship status:

- Earlier in case of BBA/BBA-IB/BBA-CA/B.Sc. (CS) courses the 100% scholarship amount of SC/ST category students used to be disbursed by the Social Welfare Department directly to the college, if the student has filled the scholarship form. But as per the new GR of Government of Maharashtra, now 40% of scholarship is disbursed to the college and remaining 60% is disbursed to the student's account directly, which the student is supposed to pay to the college within 7 days of receipt of the amount. It is observed that students do not report to the college once they receive the amount; hence it becomes very difficult to trace them and recover the pending amount. However for FY and SY the college can approach the students from time to time as they are in campus for one and two years respectively, but in case of TY, since it is an outgoing batch the students are about to leave the campus after completion of the last year. It is very difficult to recover the amount once the students complete TY. Hence, in order to avoid further discrepancies, it is decided by the committee that the college should recover the 60% amount of scholarship from the student at the time of taking admission to TY along with the total payable fees of the students.
- Scholarship form link for the AY 2022-23 is still open; students from all courses are informed through notices from time to time regarding the important dates of scholarship form. Administrative Officer Mrs. Harshala Wadkar has conducted detailed online sessions to guide the students of all courses regarding form filling, screening of the documents etc.

e. Art Circle

Ms Sneha Kashid (Girl Student' Representative) proudly mentioned about the student success in dramatics through art circle The MMCC Art circle team participated in various competitions such as Baba's Karandak, Nashik, Rasvanti Karandak, Karmveer Karandak, Purushottam Karandak, and also won various prizes and recognitions for their outstanding performances.

f. Status of purchase of additional laboratory equipment / classroom interior for MA(JMC)

Mr. Santosh Shenai briefed the members about the expenses made by MA(JMC) department, which includes the purchase of one DSLR camera costing Rs: 15000, tripod costing Rs: 2500/- and Microphone costing Rs:1500/-.

h. Library management software:

i. ERP Planning & Implementation

Prof. Nidhi Satavlekar apprised the members about the college ERP planning and implementation for AY 2023-24. The vendor of ERP system is to be changed for AY 2023-24. All members approved the change of ERP vendor and to give the contract of ERP system to vmedulife Software Company.

j. Revision of Visiting Faculty Honorarium for BBA/BBA-IB course:

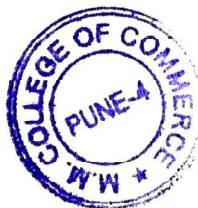

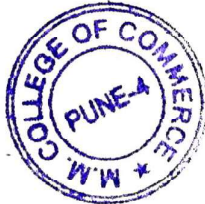

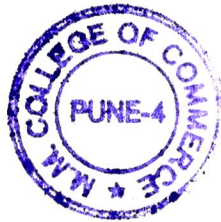
