"Fundamentals of Remote Sensing and GIS Technology (Course in Hindi)". Held online during 14th September to 28th September 2021.

Overview:

The Fundamentals of Remote Sensing and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Technology (Course in Hindi) Certificate Course was conducted by the IIRS ISRO MMCC Nodal Center during 14th Sept. to 28th Sep. 2021. The course aimed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of remote sensing principles, GIS applications, and their integration for various environmental and geospatial analyses.

Objectives:

- To introduce participants to the basic principles and concepts of remote sensing.
- To familiarize participants with the fundamentals of Geographic Information Systems (GIS).
- To demonstrate the integration of remote sensing and GIS for spatial analysis and decision-making.
- To provide hands-on experience with popular remote sensing and GIS software tools.

Participants:

The course attracted a total 54 participants from diverse backgrounds, including students, researchers and teachers involved in fields such as environmental science, computer science, geography, agriculture, and disaster management.

Course Content:

The course curriculum was structured to cover the following topics:

- ➤ Introduction to Remote Sensing
- ➤ Remote Sensing Platforms and Sensors
- ➤ Image Interpretation Techniques
- > Basics of GIS and Spatial Data
- ➤ Data Acquisition and Pre-processing
- > Spatial Analysis and Modeling

- Applications of Remote Sensing and GIS
- ➤ Hands-on Training with Software Tools (e.g., ArcGIS, QGIS, ENVI, ERDAS Imagine)

Methodology:

The course employed a combination of lectures, practical demonstrations, hands-on exercises, and interactive sessions to facilitate learning. Participants were provided with study materials, software tutorials, and datasets to reinforce their understanding. Experts from ISRO were to provide insights into real-world applications and advancements in remote sensing and GIS technology.

Outcomes:

Upon completion of the course, participants gained a solid foundation in remote sensing principles, GIS techniques, and their integration for spatial analysis. They developed practical skills in handling remote sensing data, performing geospatial analyses, and generating meaningful outputs for decision support.
