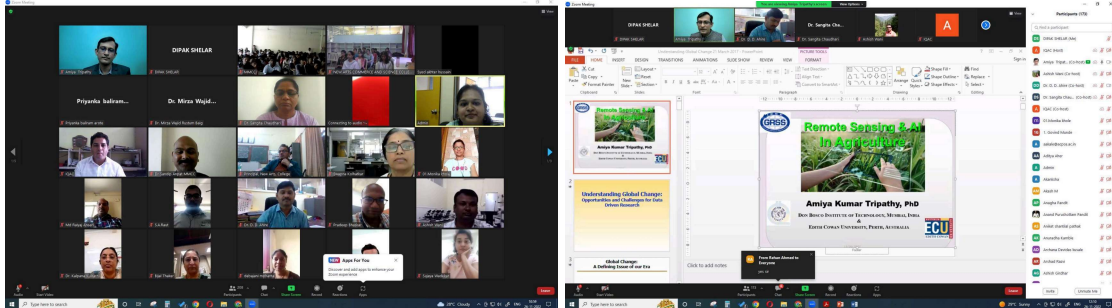


Prof. Amiya Kumar Tripathy, Chair IEEE-GRSS Bombay Chapter, in his presidential address for the seminar, highlighted the applications of Remote Sensing and ample job opportunities for societal benefit. He directed the researchers to study the earth comprised of abiotic and biotic factors, through the **'third eye in the sky'** i.e. the satellite. He further mentioned about geoscience (earth, sea topography) that when used with data science will lead to analysis and modeling in case of natural disasters and preservation of ecology. His technical session on 'Demystifying Remote Sensing and AI applications in Agriculture' discussed the challenges in data driven analysis such as data complexity, data characteristics and complex processes. He also discussed a few case studies to understand the challenges in observation and data retrieval in the field of remote sensing.

Dr. Sangita Chaudhari, Vice Chair, IEEE GRSS Bombay Chapter & Professor, RamraoAdik Institute of Technology, Nerul, Navi Mumbai, discussed 'Geospatial Intelligence: Today and Tomorrow'. She also explored the correlation between GIS and remote sensing. She also mentioned the importance of data and mechanism to generate, process such useful data for the applications for the societal benefit. Her lucid explanation of the topic through video clips made the session interactive and interesting.

Dr. Sushree Sangita Mishra, WIEA IEEE-GRSS Bombay Chapter & Associate Professor, Amity University Mumbai, detailed on 'Spatio - temporal Drought Vulnerability Assessment using Remote Sensing, GIS and multiple time scaled indices'. She defined the term drought in terms of technological scale for assessment in a research point of view. She also discussed various agricultural drought indices for the implementation of the application model. Few case studies have been discussed to understand the research going around the globe, in the field of drought assessment using remote sensing.

Mr. Munir Mohammed, Sr. Program Manager, IEEE, spoke on 'IEEE Standards for Academia'. He explored the journey of IEEE and IEEE standards and the programs offered.

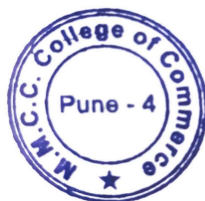

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, MMCC**

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is a significant initiative of the Government of India aimed at driving rural development through the collaboration of higher educational institutions and rural communities. MMCC, with its vision of promoting quality education and sustainable development, has taken part in this flagship program by adopting five villages in Pune district: Ambi, Agalambe, Zalanwadi, Matalwadi, and Gorhe.

In these villages, a substantial portion of the community comprises residents, spinners, farmers, and farm laborers, with agriculture and complementary businesses being the primary sources of livelihood. While primary education facilities are available, there is a notable lack of interest in education among some backward communities, leading to a high dropout rate at the primary level. Many children are deprived of education as they accompany their parents to work in wage labor, rather than attending school.

To address these challenges, MMCC, as part of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, has engaged with village stakeholders, including the Sarpanch, Gram Sevak, and other Panchayat members. The motto and objectives of the program were discussed with them, fostering an understanding of the shared goals. Additionally, a household survey was conducted to gain insights into the specific needs and requirements of the villages.

To improve healthcare in these rural areas, health camps were organized, providing primary health checkups for villagers and school children. Specific initiatives like breast cancer awareness and checkups were conducted in collaboration with hospitals.

Furthermore, to encourage education and mentorship opportunities in these villages, four-day value education programs were held at the schools. Through these initiatives, students benefited from enhanced educational facilities and were exposed to issues prevalent in rural areas. The student volunteers actively participated in all activities, witnessing positive role models and gaining insights into moral values, gender equality, respect, and the importance of education.

The faculty members of MMCC have also played a crucial role in the success of the program, showing enthusiastic engagement and commitment to the cause.

Overall, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan has facilitated the transformational change in rural development processes in these adopted villages by leveraging the expertise of MMCC and other higher educational institutions. The collaborative efforts aim to accelerate sustainable growth and improve the overall well-being of rural communities in India.

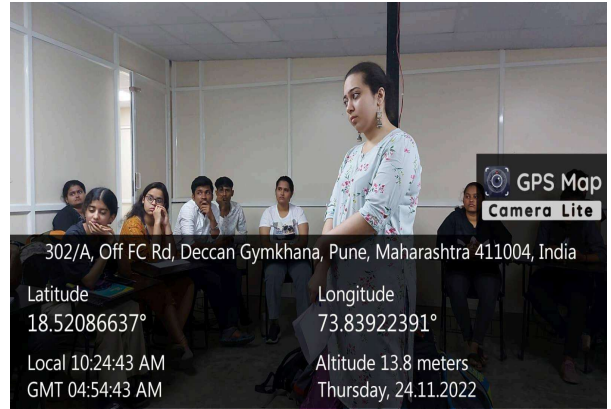
It was good to be able to connect with you over the phone today!

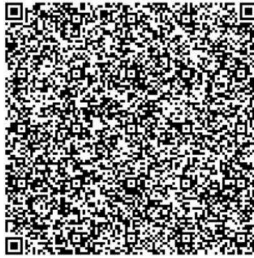
