3.1 & 3.2 Events/conferences/ workshops/cultural programs organized by college (1/08/2019 to 31/01/2020):

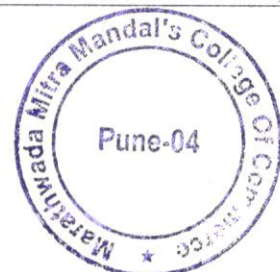
Sr. No	Date	Event

3	13 th August,	Road Safety Awareness Program was organized on 13 th



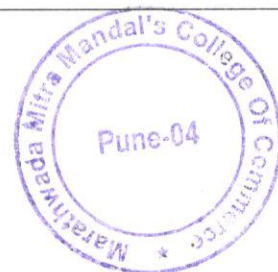

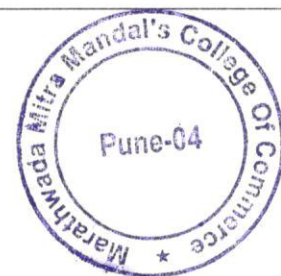
		Seemita Bose Choudhary. 51 students were attended the lecture.
