Profile of Teachers

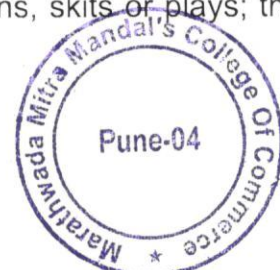

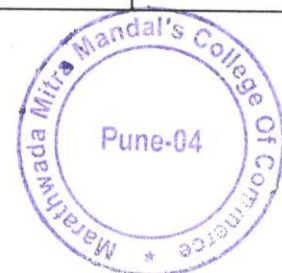
1. Pegasus
